No Marker Found — Existing fence corner in place now used for property division. Assumed to be at proper location.

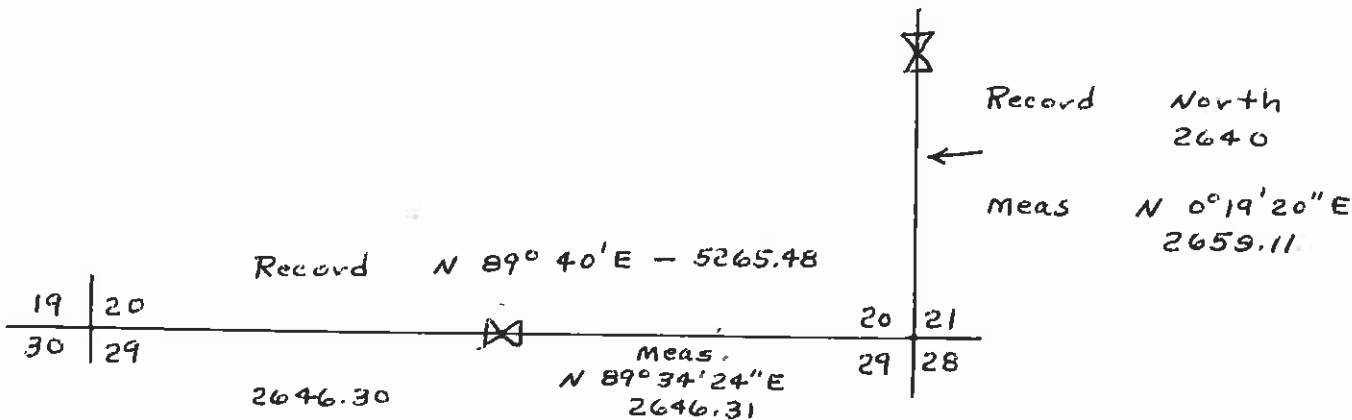

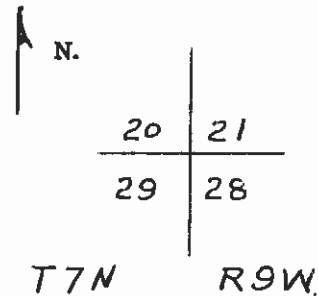
