FOUND- 4" CONCRETE R/W MONUMENT SET BY HIGHWAY DEPT. FOR N 1/4 COR. SEC. 11.

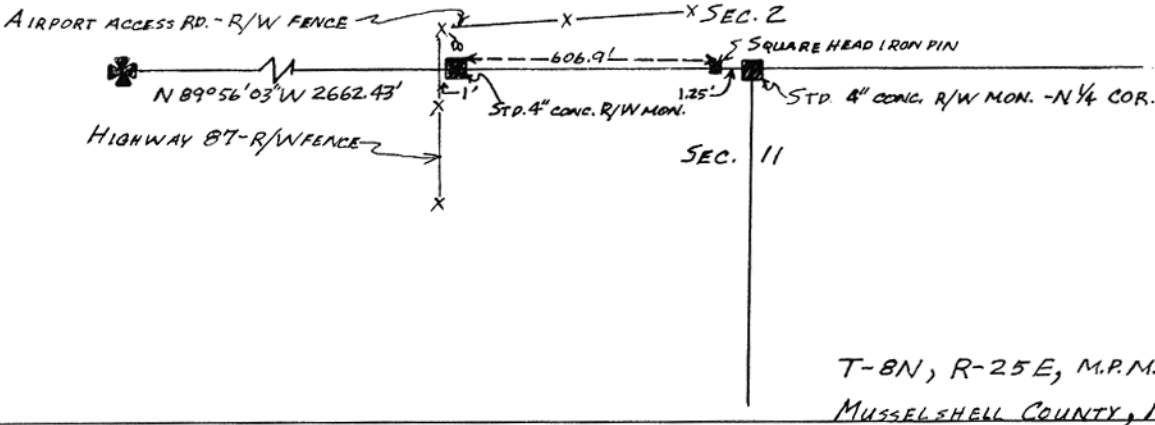

2. A STANDARD 4" CONG. R/W MON BEARS WEST 608.1'.

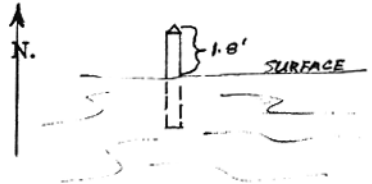
