Corner E 1/4 SECTION 26 T. 15N R. 18E P.M.M. FERGUS County

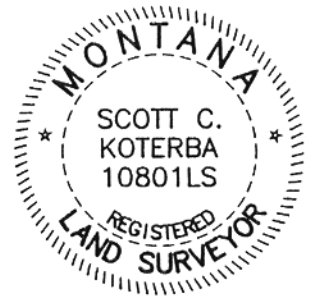
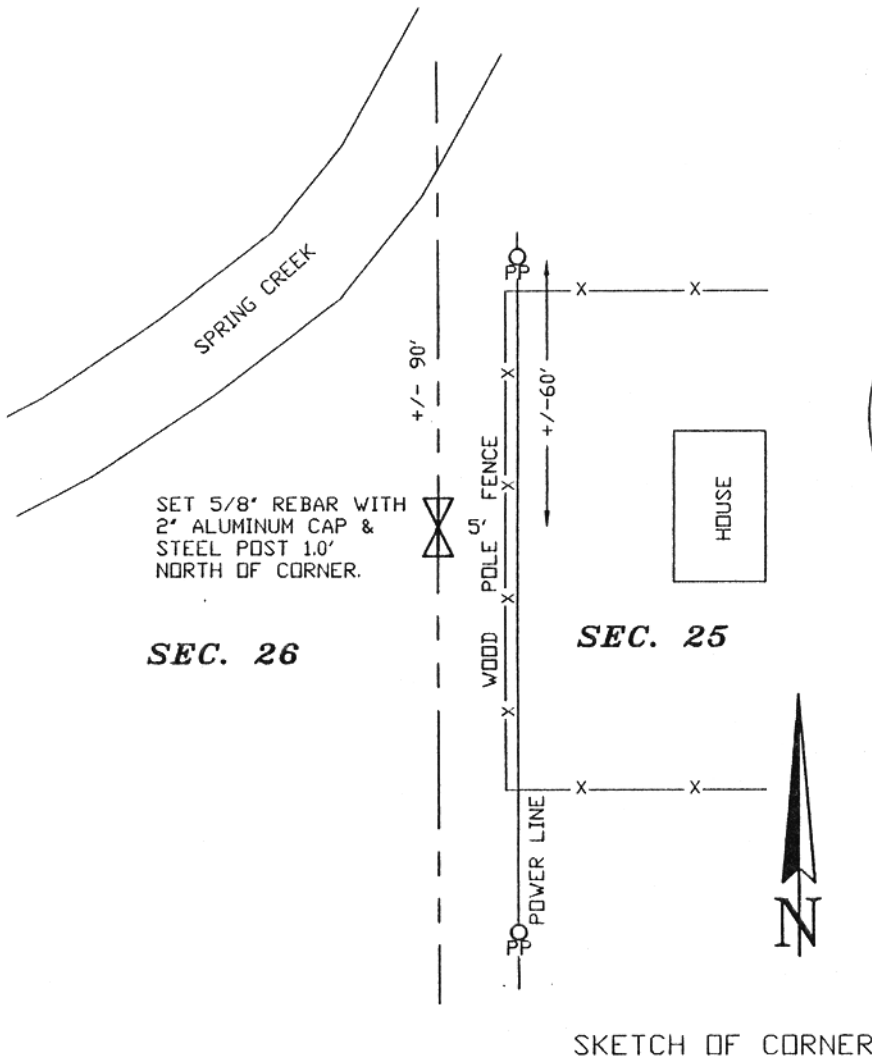
ORIGINAL RECORD: (Robinson, 1882) Set a sandstone 11 x 9 x 6 ins. 7 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor. marked 1/4 on W. face. Dug pits 18 x 18 x 12 ins. in each sec. 5 1/2 ft. dist and raised a mound of earth 2 ft high 4 1/2 ft base alongside.

SUBSEQUENT RECORD: C/S 570 shows proportion position for breakdown of Section 25.

EVIDENCE FOUND: No original evidence found due to farming and building construction.

PERPETUATION: Set 5/8" rebar with 2" aluminum cap per C/S 570 at the proportion distance between section corners and the line between the South 1/16 corner and the northeast of Section 26.
