INSTRUCTIONS

1. Original and/or subsequent record used to evaluate the corner position.
2. Description of evidence found, note discrepancies in the record, state method of establishing lost or obliterated corners.
3. Description of monument and accessories set to perpetuate the corner position.
4. Sketch or corner, show all pertinent data which can best be shown in a sketch example, corner marking, topography lines, position of accessories, etc.
5. Certification must be signed and sealed by Registered Land Surveyor in State of Montana.
6. Fill in Cross Index & Section Diagram at bottom of sheet.

Corner #94 SW Corner Section 35 T. 16 N R. 12 E P.M.M. Judith Basin County

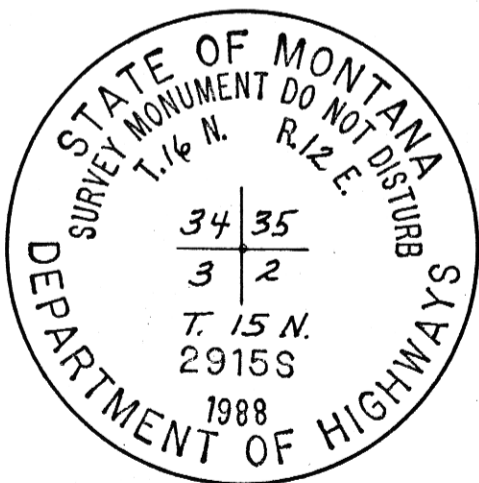
RECORD: 80 chains "set a sandstone 15 x 8 x 7 ins. 10 ins in the ground for corner to Sec's. 2. 3. 34 & 35 Marked with - 2 notches on E. and 4 notches on W. edges and raised a mound of stone alongside."

FOUND: Depression in ground at intersection of old destroyed fence with rocks shrewn around the area. No evidence of marked stone. An old road runs to the East.

METHOD: I reestablish the section corner of the apparent intersection of the old destroyed fences and in line with the center of the road to the East.

SET: A 3 1/4 inch diameter aluminum cap riveted to a 30 inch flared aluminum tube 2 1/2 inches in diameter and marked as shown and place a steel survey marker post alongside. (Cap is 6" out of the ground)

ACCESSORIES: The 1/4 corners to the North and to the East are as follows: N. 00° 58' 46" W., - 2,720.40 feet N. 89° 36' 29" E., - 2,651.52 feet

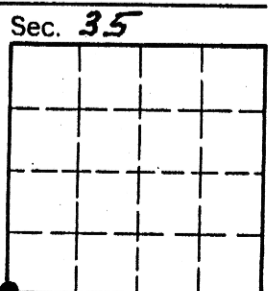
