DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

Found no evidence of original stone or bearing trees.

Record: Set a granite stone 24x6x5 inches 18 inches in the ground, from which a 10 inch pine bears N 61° E, 18 lks distance marked 1/4 S B.T. A 10 inch pine bears N 23° W, 41 lks distance marked 1/4 S B.T.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

Set a 2" by 30" brass capped 28 inches deep in the ground stamped as shown. From which A 8inch L. P. Pine bears S 24 3/4° W and 45.5 ft. A 12inch L. P. Pine bears S 74° W and 74.3 ft.

Both trees blazed and scribed R.M. Painted blazes red posted B.T. and attention signs.



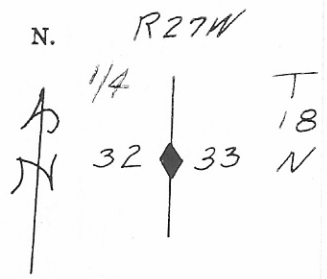
