Corner South east, Section Corner Sec.5 T. 28 N, R. 39 E, P.M.M.

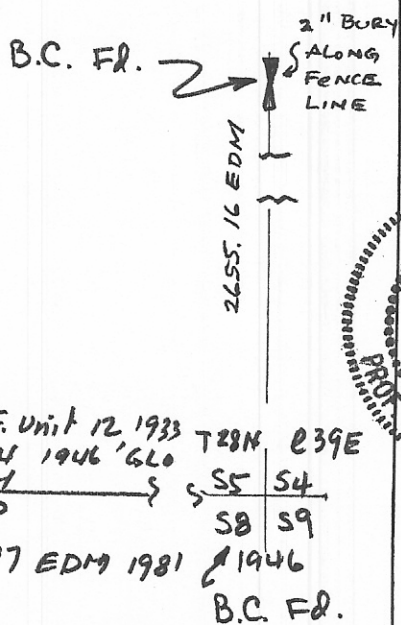
80.30 The corner of section 4,5,8 and 9, marked by the remains of the original monument, a broken limestone of indeterminate size, alongside which is a driven steel axle shaft 1" in diameter, buried 24 ins. below the surface of the graded road. At the corner point, set an iron post 3 ft. long 2 ins. diameter 48 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked.

from which an iron post 3 ft. long 2" diameter set 34" in the ground for reference monument bears N45°E 71 lks. dist. with brass cap marked S4RM1946 and an arrow pointing toward the corner. An iron post 3 ft. long 2 ins. diameter set 27 ins. in the ground for reference monument bears S45°N, 81 lks. dist. marked S8RM1946.

Evidence Found

The corner in \emptyset of county road 2" bury marked as stated. The RM's located were found 37.2" North and South of the corner rather than at 45° as stated. The iron post was 1" in lieu of 2" for the R.M. The one (N) R.M. was marked S5RM1946 and the South RM was marked S9RM1946.

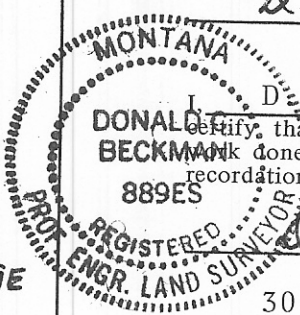
