

CERTIFIED LAND CORNER RECORDATION

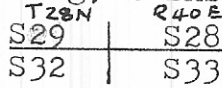
Corner ^E ~~SW~~ Corner of Section 29 T. 28 N., R. 40E, P.M.M.

GLO RECORD

The cor. of sec. 28,29,32,and 33, marked by the corner post of fence bearing N. and E. This post occupies the original corner position; it was identified by Adam Lenz, a settler who occupied adjoining lands at the time the original survey was executed.

At the corner point,

Set an iron post, 3 ft ong, 2 ins. diam, 34 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

from which an iron post, 4 ins diameter, projecting 12" above ground with standard bronze cap mkd. for a B.M. of the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation, elev 2081.58 ft., bears N 70 lks. dist.

A brass tablet, 3 inches diam., imbedded in the N. headwall of bridge aboutment, bears S 1-00W, 6 chains distant. the brass tablet has been marked, but the only remaining figures are badly battered.

EVIDENCE FOUND

The iron post and brass cap marked as stated, and the fences as described. The RMs were evident, but the one on the canal bridge headwall was missing, as the concrete wall had failed, but the distance to the headwall agreed. No additional RM's were set.

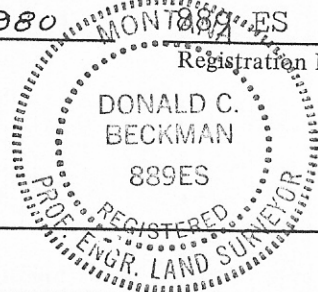


DIAGRAM OF CORNER
