2. Description of evidence found, note discrepancies in the record, state method of establishing lost or obliterated corners.
3. Description of monument and accessories set to perpetuate the corner position.
4. Sketch or corner, show all pertinent data which can best be shown in a sketch example, corner marking, topography ties, position of accessories, etc.
5. Certification must be signed and sealed by Registered Land Surveyor in State of Montana.
6. Fill in Cross Index & Section Diagram at bottom of sheet.

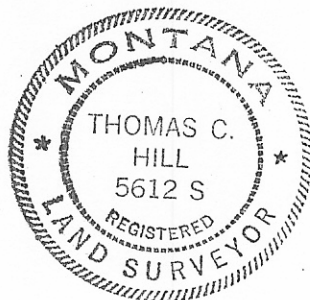
I, 1963 record; As per recordation form Book 1, page 4; filed by J. W. Nineman "534ES".

III. Established S12 BT;
A 10" Lodgepole Pine bears N57°E., 59.3 ft. Mrk. "1/4S12Bt"

Attached location poster to an 8" Doug. Fir which bears S55°W., 10.9 ft.

Painted red bands around BT's and attached BT signs.

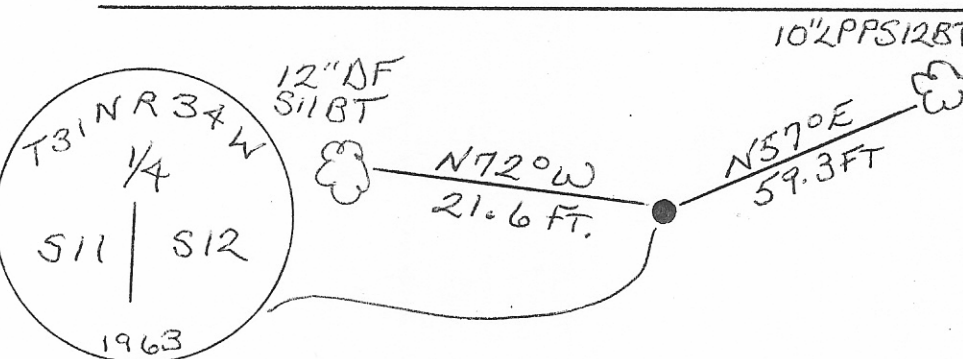

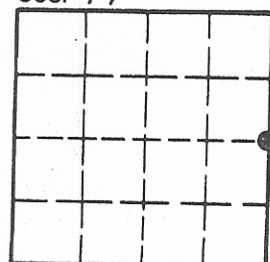
