

**CERTIFIED LAND CORNER RECORDATION**

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

Found a granite stone measuring 9"x9"x8" above ground firmly set in the ground with 1 notch on the east face and 3 notches on the south face, and a "x" chiseled on top. A center-punched 5/8" rebar is on the south side of the stone. The stone is surrounded by a 5-foot diameter mound of stone. An old 4"x4" wood post is loosely set in the mound south of the stone. (Record: East on a true line bet. Sections 14 and 23. Var. 19° E. 80. chs. Point 150 ft. above ravine. Set granite stone 14x12x10 in. 9 in. in the ground for cor. to Secs. 13,14,23, and 24, marked 3 notches on S. and 1 on E. edges and raised a mound of stone alongside. Pits impracticable.)

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED  
TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

Date of work: 4/24/81

Darkened the "x" and notches and painted the stone orange. Set two R.M.'s (5/8"x2' rebar with aluminum Surv-Kap and a mound of stone around each) such that R.M. West bears N 89°48'23" W, 8.41 feet and R.M. South bears S 00°01'04" E, 8.63 feet. Set a metal post northerly, 7.3 feet with a M.A.R.L.S. marker on the north side.

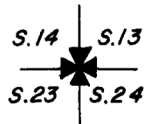
