Found: A rebar, 5/8" diameter extends 4" above ground, no cap from which a found rebar, 5/8" diameter flush with AC 2" diameter, marked as a Reference Monument. Bears N., 9.8' distance. The bald rebar is set on the N side of an old axe cut cedar post, in a fence line extend N-S and an abandoned fence extending W.
