Found: A granite boulder, 12x8x8 inches. Partially overgrown, lying flat on the ground. On the side facing up,  
found 4 chisel marks. On the side facing south, found 1 chisel mark. 1 foot north of a fence interior found a  
hollow indentation. I accept this as the original location of the stone. 3 ½ feet southeast of recovered location.  
Fences extend north, south and north west. Reset stone upright with 4 chisel marks on east and 1 chisel mark on  
south.
