

**CERTIFIED LAND CORNER RECORDATION**

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

ORIGINAL RECORD OF MAY 17, 1877

Set a sandstone 26x14x2 ins. 19 ins. in the ground for cor. to secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33 marked with 2 notches on the W. and 4 on the E. edges.

FOUND:

Sandstone 10x2 ins., 8 ins. above ground, standing upright with base partly deteriorated, in a small depression, at the centerline extensions of a west and north County Road corner. Stone is clearly marked with 2 notches on the west and 4 notches on the East faces.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER: 41-1A-40

Removed stone and in place thereof;

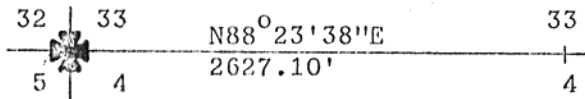
Date of work: April 5, 1977
