1868 field notes - Set 1/4 sec. cor. a post in mound of earth with pits charred stake (te?) as per instructions.

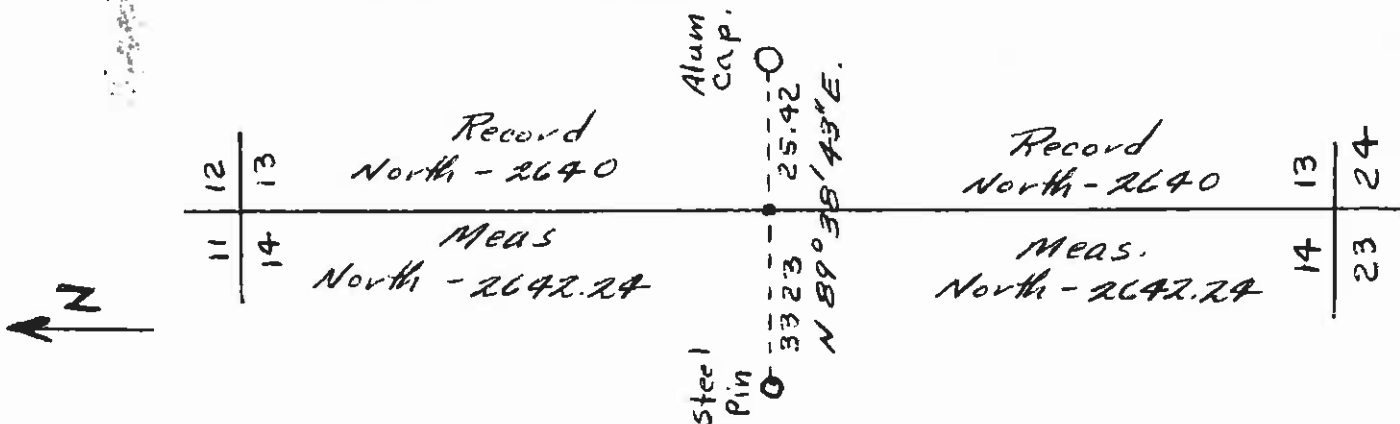
No marker for cor. found - falls in road in county lane - found 3/4" steel pin under fence line on west side of lane - on line with existing fence west of lane.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

No marker set for actual corner. (falls in road) - used found steel pin as one ref. cor. & set 5/8" x 24" rebar with 1 1/2" Alum Survey Cap. stamped R.G. MASTERS RLS 821 and marked 1/4 W.C. 25.42 as other ref. cor. N 89° 38' 43" E from cor. location.

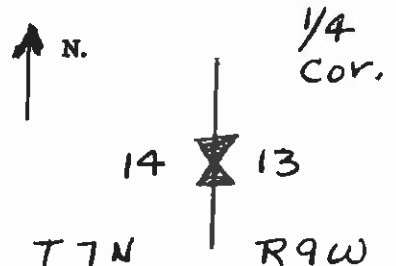
