Corner SOUTH 1/4 SECTION 17 T. 16N R. 12E P.M.M. JUDITH BASIN County

ORIGINAL RECORD: (Parsons 1882) Set sandstone 12 x 8 x 4 ins. 8 ins. in the ground for 1/4 sec. cor. marked 1/4 on N. face. dug pits 18 x 18 x 12 ins E & W of stone 5 1/2 ft. dist. and raised a mound of earth 1 1/2 ft. high 3 1/2 ft. base along side

SUBSEQUENT RECORD: (1985) C/S 100 by Ries - Shows found fence corner and stone at corner position with tie to set Center 1/4 corner of Section 17

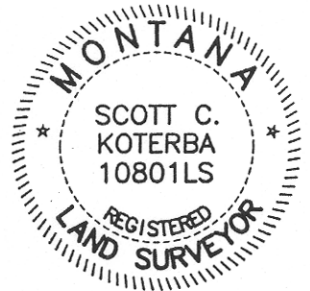
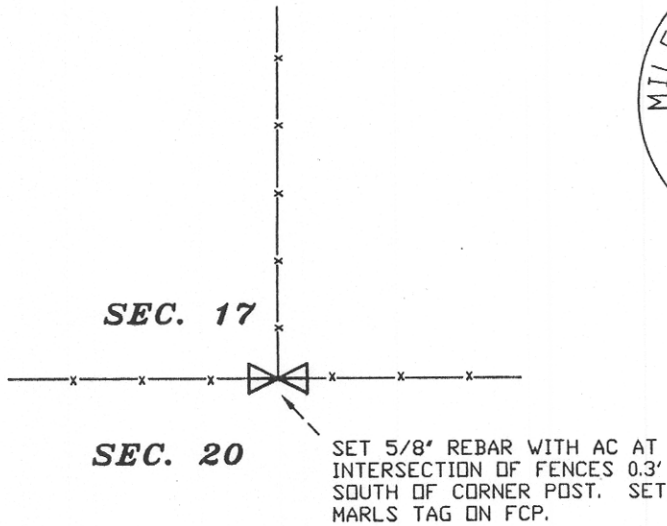
EVIDENCE FOUND: (July, 2001) No monument was found at the fence corner. After conversations with Mr. Ries, it appears that he intended to use the same fence corner that was found by our crews. Even though there is a 33 foot distance difference between his and our measurement to the Center 1/4 of Section 17. The fence corner has been in place for more than 20 years.

PERPETUATION: At the base of the fence corner post, set a 5/8" rebar with 2" aluminum cap marked as shown below for the South 1/4 corner to Section 17. See drawing below.
