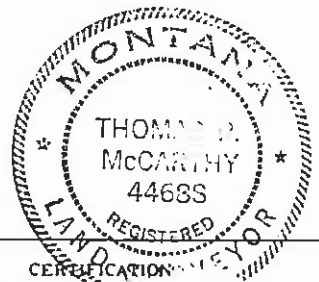
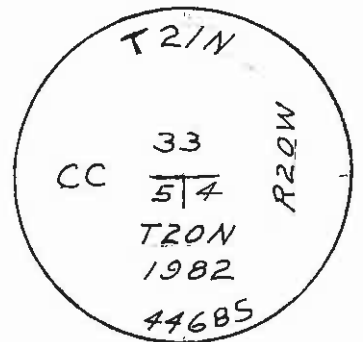
CERTIFIED CORNER RECORDATION

RECORD GLO (1905): Set a slate stone, 14x10x8 ins., 9 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. of secs. 4 and 5, marked CC on S., with 4 grooves on E. and 2 grooves on W. face; dig pits, 24x18x12 ins., crosswise on each line, E. and W., 3 ft., and S. of stone, 7 ft. dist., and raise a mound of earth, 4 ft. base, 2 ft. high S. of cor.

FOUND: No evidence found; position falls in R/W State Highway 211 [F.A.S. S-306(2)].

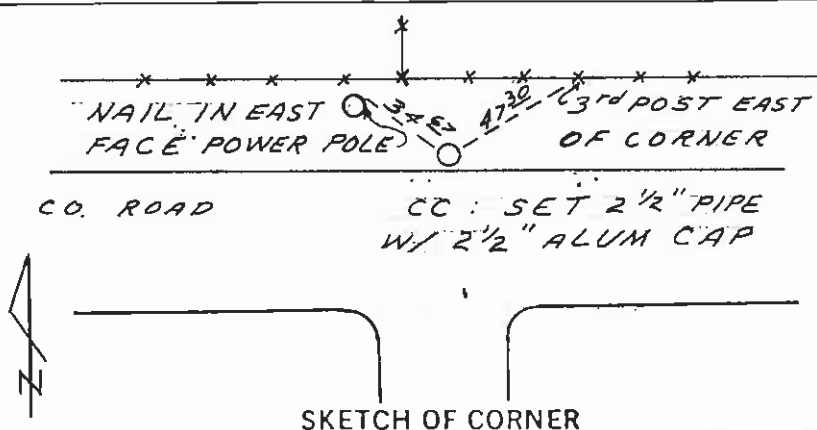
SET: 2 1/2" pipe with 2 1/2" aluminum cap stamped as shown. Positioned 15' north of centerline F.A.S. S-306(2) per plans and centerline of road to south. See reverse side for ties to other corners.
