5. Certification must be signed and sealed by Land Surveyor licensed in the State of Montana.
6. Fill in index information and show the corner's approximate location within the section diagram.

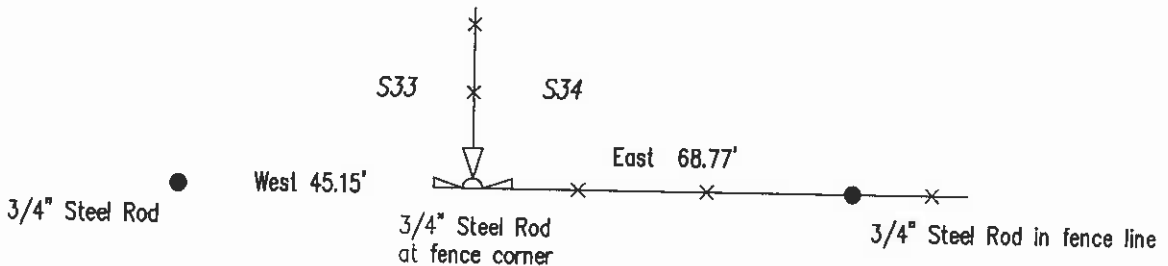
ORIGINAL RECORD: Set 12"x10"x8" flint stone.

EVIDENCE FOUND: No evidence of original stone or accessories found. I find a 3/4" steel rod.

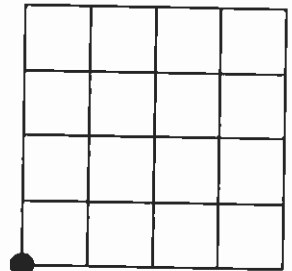
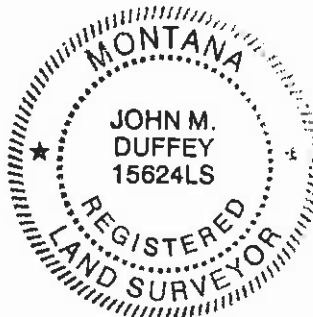
DISCUSSION: 3/4" steel rod shown as section corner on COS 2597. Origin of found steel rod unknown.
