2. Description of evidence found, note discrepancies in the record.
3. Description of monument and accessories set to perpetuate the corner position.
4. Sketch of corner, show all pertinent data.
5. Certification must be signed and sealed by Land Surveyor licensed in the State of Montana.
6. Fill in index information and show the corner's approximate location within the section diagram.

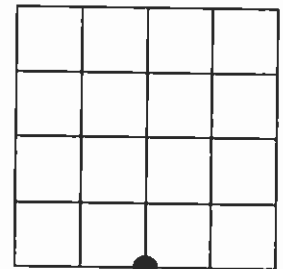
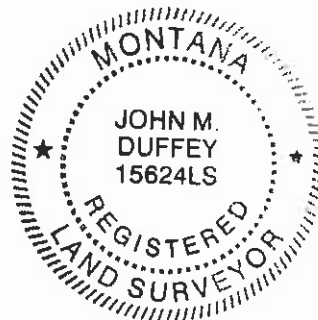
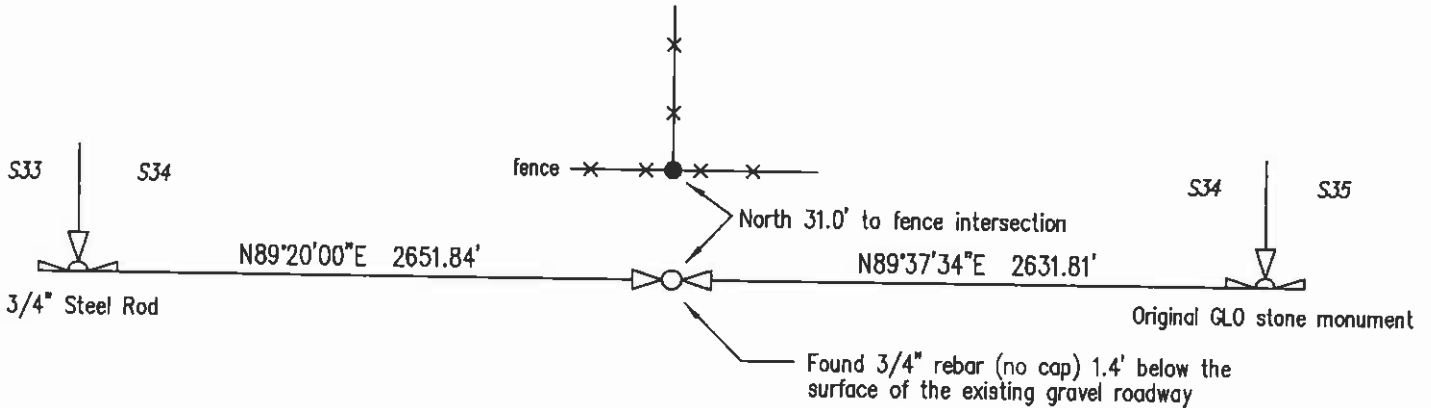
Corner: S1/4 Corner Section 34 T. 25N R. 21W P.M.M. Lake County
