

**CERTIFIED LAND CORNER RECORDATION**

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

From: "Subdivisional lines of T9S, R8E". 1883. (1697-453)

"Set granite stone, 12x10x6 ins., 8 ins. in the ground.... marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on N face, & raised a mound of stone alongside."

Found: An irregular granitic stone of nominal size, lying on the north face (downhill) under a cairn of rock. Marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on down face.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED  
TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

Date of work: 7/12/76

Reset rock in original position; cut an "x" in the top; drove a 5/8-in. x 2 ft. rebar alongside the north face for support & magnetic response.  
Rebuilt mound of stone.
