DESCRIPTION OF CORNER EVIDENCE FOUND, AND ORIGINAL RECORD (IF KNOWN)

From: "Subdivisional lines of T9S, R8E". 1883. (1697-458)

"Set a magnetite stone 16x14x10 in., 11 ins. in the ground marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on W face and raised a mound of stone alongside".

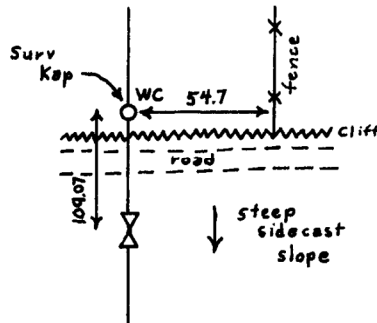
Found: At proportionate distance between NW and SW section corners: large sidecast boulders immediately below a quarry road. Assumed that original corner lost.

DESCRIPTION OF MONUMENT AND ACCESSORIES ESTABLISHED TO PERPETUATE THE ORIGINAL LOCATION OF THIS CORNER:

Date of work: 7/17/76

Set a Surv Kap as a witness corner as follows:

WC is N 0°05'32" W a distance of 109.07 feet from the single proportionate location of the missing 1/4 corner.

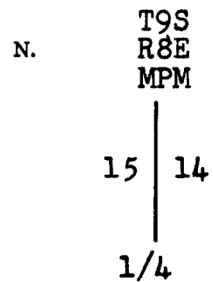
