Found: Original Fir, Sec 5 (S44°30′E) bearing tree with partially healed blaze. The corner monument was recovered, which is a 30″ iron post, 2″ in diameter with a B.C. marked as described in original notes, but it had fallen into the irrigation ditch called out in original notes. It appears the ditch has been recently improved and expanded, therefore the true corner position now lands on the steep cut slope of the ditch. The other bearing tree was also destroyed by the ditch. Corner position was calculated from the remaining bearing tree using the record bearing and distance. Corner and bearing tree are located on a steep NW slope.
