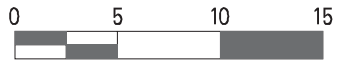
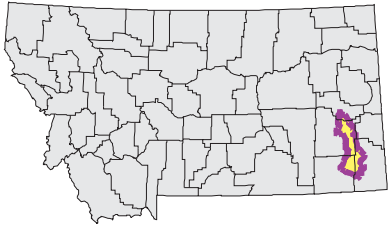


LOWER POWDER Watershed

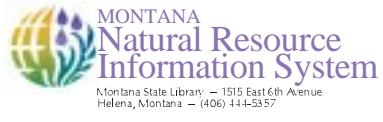
Slope Classes from NED
