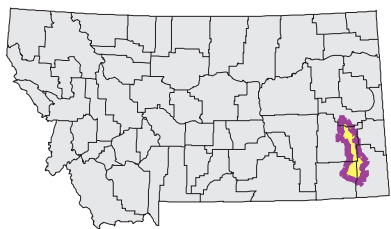
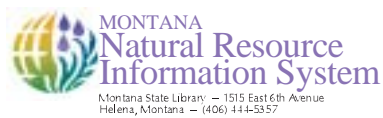


LOWER POWDER Watershed
