









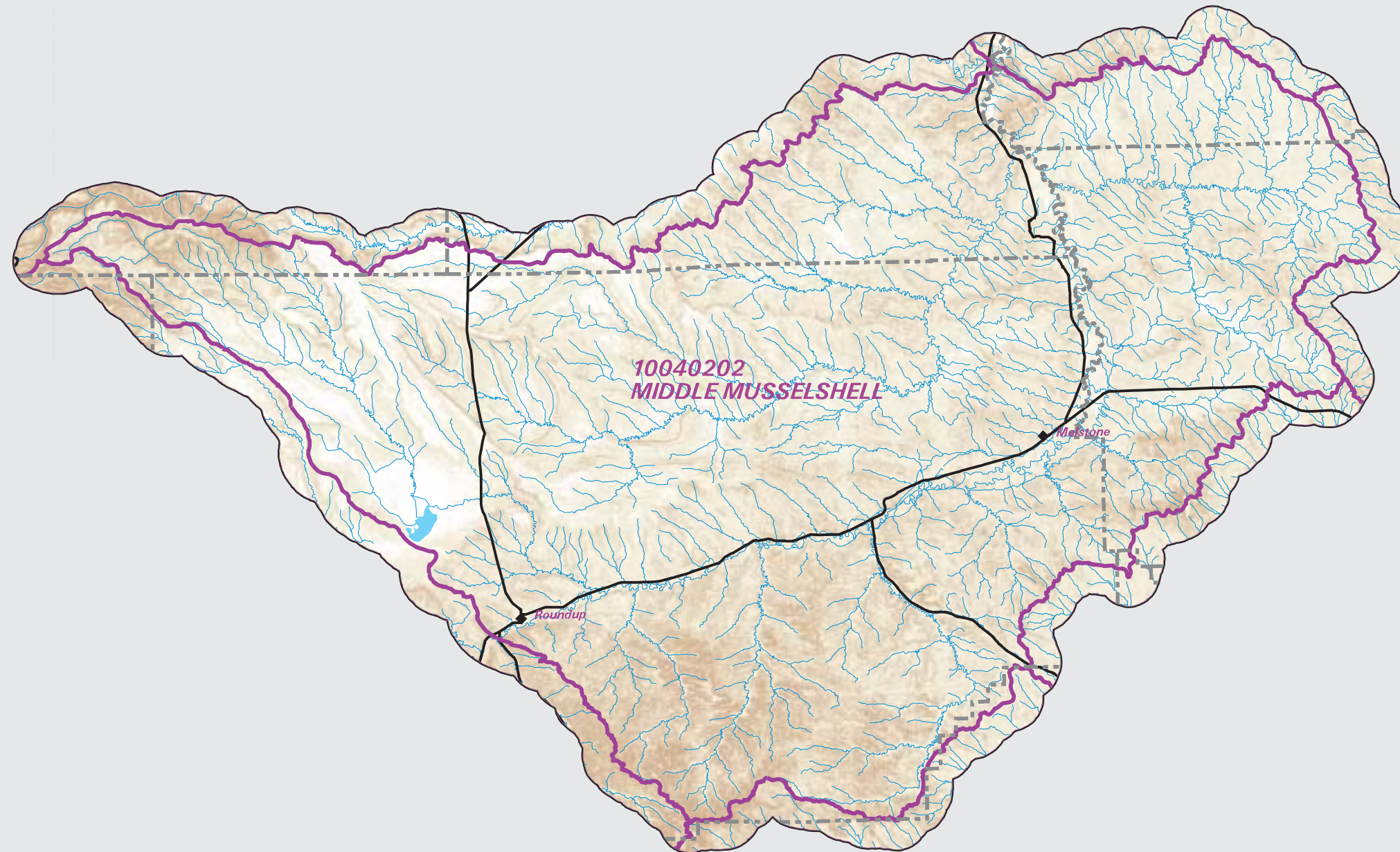


MIDDLE MUSSELHELL Watershed

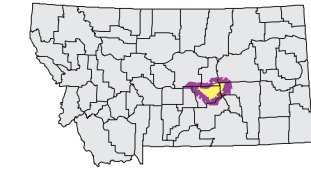

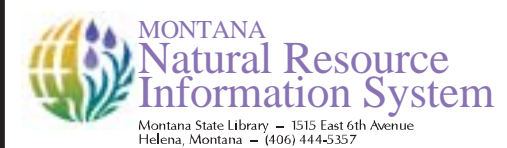
